Guidelines:

Graduating seniors residing on the south side of Fort Wayne
Cumulative grade point average of 3.5 or above
Acceptance at an accredited 2-year/4-year university
Family income below state poverty guidelines (Documentation will be requested)

Requirements:

Documentation of community service/extra-curricular involvement
Three (3) community references (include contact information)
A 2-3 page essay describing desire for post-education, area of study/plans for opportunity, and how degree will be used to help others upon completion. Essay must be typed (12-point font) and double-spaced. Must include cover page with name, phone number, e-mail address, and high school name. **All essays, references, and community service/extra-curricular documentation must be submitted by May 30, 2009 at 12 midnight.**

Selection Process:

Scholarship committee will evaluate prospective recipients' essays for content, grammar and punctuation, and relevance on scale from 1 to 5 for each category along with guidelines and other requirements. Top three applicants will be selected and announced **June 27, 2009**. Monies will be received in the form of a cashier's check written out to educational institution.

Recognition:

Recipients will also receive an award and certificate at luncheon in their honor where they will read essays.
